

## **3D Print America!** Contest Announcement

The U.S. Consulate General in St. Petersburg is happy to announce a new contest which will allow you to demonstrate your creativity, get to know 3D printing and enjoy this exciting innovation!

We challenge you to create 3D models of major American monuments ready to print! This could be either miniature replicas or works inspired by the actual monuments.

The contest is open to anyone older than 16 years old and living in the North West region of Russia.

To enter the 3D Print America contest:

1. Create a 3D model of any major American monument using any available 3D modeling software (<http://tinkercad.com/>, <http://www.3dtin.com/>, or any other to your liking).
2. Export and download your creation as an **.stl** file (this is the standard file for designing 3D objects).
3. Email your **.stl** file along with a brief description of your project idea in English to [SPbPAS@state.gov](mailto:SPbPAS@state.gov) with “3D Print” in the Subject line.

The contest ends at 11:59pm MSK on December, 1. Only submissions that are entered before this date will be considered.

You may present your entry as an individual or work in a team. Any 3D model that is 100% your own work will be accepted. There may be only one entry for person/team.

At least three winners will be selected. The winners will be selected by a panel of judges, based on the creativity, originality, relevance, complexity, technical difficulty, execution and overall aesthetics of the submissions.

The winners will be awarded 3D Printing Pens!
