**U.S. Embassy in Khartoum Signs an MOU with the Sudanese Ministry of Education  
for the English Language Fellowship Program**

Today, March 20, 2014, the Embassy of the United States of America signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Ministry of Education of the Government of Sudan to begin a partnership regarding the hosting and placement of a Senior English Language Fellow at the Ministry of Education's Sudan National Centre for Languages (SELTI).

The program is the first of its kind in Sudan, and highly demonstrates the Embassy's commitment in cementing its ties with the Sudanese people, in addition to striving to advance the level of English Language in Sudan.

The signing ceremony was held at the Ministry of Education and was attended by the U.S. Embassy's Public Affairs Officer Ronald Hawkins and Deputy Public Affairs Officer Caroline Schneider in addition to the Sudanese Ministry's Undersecretary Elsir Elshiekh and the Director of the Sudan National Centre, Nada Sidahmed Al-Jack.
