Electrician

Major duties and responsibilities of this position include, but are not limited to the following:

Maintains electrical systems and associated equipment of office buildings, warehouses, residential quarters and other government-owned or leased buildings by performing electrical preventative maintenance and repair work. Performs preventative maintenance and repair work on generators and associated systems. Maintains plumbing fixtures, systems and associated equipment of office buildings, warehouses, residential quarters and other Government-owned or leased buildings by performing preventative maintenance and repair work. Performs full journeyman level skilled electrical work. May drive a light truck to transport tools, equipment, and materials to work site.

Required Qualifications:

NOTE: All applicants must address each of the selection requirements detailed below with specific and comprehensive information supporting each item:

1. Completion of secondary school is required. Completion of vocational training or apprenticeship recognized as producing journeyman mechanic skills is required.
2. One year of journeyman electrician mechanic experience is required. At least one year experience in additional building trade (including carpentry, masonry, painting, pipe-fitting, plumbing, and/or welding) at the semi-skilled level is also required.
3. Level II English ability (limited) Speaking/Writing is required. (WILL BE TESTED)

4. Must have full journeyman knowledge of electrical systems and established practices and procedures in the electrician's trade. Must have knowledge at the semi-skilled level of established practices and procedures in at least one other building trade (as above).

5. Must have good interpersonal skills, be able to use all the tools of the trades, and possess valid local driver's license for light truck.

Note: All applicants will have to take a competency exam.
