On behalf of the U.S. Department of Energy, I would like to invite you to join me and energy minister counterparts from across the African continent at the U.S.-Africa Energy Ministerial, which will be held in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia on June 3-4, 2014. Co-hosted by the Governments of Ethiopia and the United States, the Ministerial will focus on "Catalyzing Sustainable Energy Growth in Africa." It will provide a forum for engagement with energy decision makers to support energy sector development throughout the African continent.

A series of interactive sessions will examine effective policies and technologies for expanding renewable energy use, improving energy efficiency, developing mini-grids, harnessing natural gas resources, building governance frameworks to enable private sector investment, identifying financing for infrastructure projects, and more.
