## **Scope of work**

**LOCATION: American Club – U.S Embassy Dar Es Salaam; 686 Old Bagamoyo Road.**

**Supply and install new underground water pipe line for the support compound – 300 running meters**

**From Existing underground water tank at the entrance to the over ground tank farm at the back complete with electric water pump set.**

### **SCOPE OF WORKS:**

1. Prepare and excavate appropriate trench /channel for water pipe installation. The trench shall be minimum 500mm deep to receive the pipes and accessories.
2. Provide a protective layer bed of river sand in the trench and Install high pressure water pipe line consisting of 2inches H.D.P.E. coil pipe Class C complete with all appropriate fittings and connections.
3. Also, install in the same trench appropriate power control cable for the pump control.
4. After pressures testing the completed pipe line system, back fill firstly with river sand, lay warning tape indicating Water Pipe Line, and finally the normal earth backfill. Compact and make good the trenched area.
5. At the existing underground water tank, supply and install appropriate standard submersible electric water pump capable of pumping water to the tank farm 300metrs away. The pump set shall be complete with controls and floats for automatic start on when the tank farm calls for water and shuts down when the tanks are full. Also, it should have dry run protection when the source of water is low.
6. Provide a simple canopy / roof over the pump controls to protect against rain and sun.
7. Test and commission the completed water supply system and hand over with appropriate paper works to the Embassy.
8. Demobilize and clear all the debris from site.

### **NOTES:**

1. The Contractor shall furnish and supply all materials required by this scope of work.
2. The contractor should survey the property and verify the work required against the scope of works to determine if any discrepancies exist. The contractor shall be responsible for any errors, which might have been avoided by such a survey/review.
3. The contract will be a firm fixed price contract payable entirely in the currency indicated in the bid. No additional sums will be payable on account of any escalation in the cost of materials, equipment or labor, or because of the contractor's failure to properly estimate or accurately predict the cost or difficulty of achieving the results required by this scope of works.
