SCOPE OF WORK

LOCATION: American Club – U.S Embassy Dar Es Salaam; 686 Old Bagamoyo Road.

New Concrete Tennis Court.

SCOPE OF WORKS:

1. Completely break and remove entirely the existing concrete tennis court up to the sub base soil. Cart away all debris from site.
2. Cut the sub soil to at least 300mm deep and compact the area thoroughly using vibrating compactor roller.
3. Supply and lay good appropriate quality murrum to make up level to receive 200mm hard core, 50mm sand bed and 150mm thick cement concrete. Compact thoroughly the murrum laid using vibrating compactor roller.
4. Supply and lay 200mm hard core base and 50mm thick sand bed thoroughly compacted with vibrating roller ready to receive a reinforced concrete slab.
5. Lay new reinforced concrete floor 150mm thick; grade 20 concrete. The concrete to be reinforced with 10mm, 150mm center to center BRC, spaced 75mm from bottom.
6. The concrete finish shall be steel float finish. Additive mineral dry shake floor hardener (Sikafloor -3 QuartzTop ZA) shall be used.
7. The completed concrete slab shall have natural gradient for drainage – rain water shall naturally drain away – no ponding
8. Each ½ court should be cast at one time with no intervening joints.
9. Allow adequate time for curing. Prepare for painting.
10. Apply 2 coats of primer compatible with the surface and two coats of rubber based tennis court specialized paint - color green.
11. Apply 2 coats of Paint for Tennis court playing lines; color white. Use appropriate PVA acrylic floor paint compatible with the surface.
12. Prepare the tennis court for hand over - clean and cart away the dirt etc.

NOTES:

1. The Contractor shall furnish and supply all materials required by this scope of work.
2. The contractor should survey the property and verify the work required against the scope of works to determine if any discrepancies exist. The contractor shall be responsible for any errors, which might have been avoided by such a survey/review.
3. The contract will be a firm fixed price contract payable entirely in the currency indicated in the bid. No additional sums will be payable on account of any escalation in the cost of materials, equipment or labor, or because of the contractor's failure to properly estimate or accurately predict the cost or difficulty of achieving the results required by this scope of works.
4. On award of the contract, the contractor shall furnish detailed working drawing / installation/ construction procedure for approval. No works shall be carried out without approval.
