- ✘ Monitor and evaluate ongoing activities of HIV/AIDS prevention, care and treatment for adults, women and orphans in military bases
- ✘ Observe, assess and strengthen the peer educator program
- ✘ Revise the reporting procedures and data transmission processes
- ✘ Impart most recent guidance and documentation related to patient screening, individual- and group counseling

Bases in Kara, Niamtougou, Sokodé, Atakpamé and Kpalimé were visited and the cross country information gathering trip was deemed a success.
