

Per the press release from the Central Bank of Tunisia dated Nov 08, 2012, the following banknotes will cease to be legal tender from 1 January 2013:

- 1) 20 dinars (type 1992)
- 2) 30 dinars (type 1997)
- 3) 50 dinars (type 2008)

According to the same source, 20 dinar and 50 dinar notes will be replaced because they contain symbols of the former regime, while the 30 dinar note is being withdrawn from the market for its inefficiency in daily financial transactions.

These three types of bills (see attached photos) will be exchanged at local branches of the Central Bank of Tunisia (BCT) and at branches in different regions of the country until 31 December 2017.
