Purpose:

The FLTA is an opportunity for young teachers of English to refine their teaching skills, increase their English language proficiency and extend their knowledge of American culture and customs while strengthening the instruction of the Arabic language at U.S. colleges and universities.

Program sponsors and managers:

The FLTA program is sponsored by the U.S. Department of State, Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs, and administered by the American Center and the Institute of International Education in New York.

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be teachers of English or in training to become teachers of English;
- Aged between 21 and 29 years old at the time of application;
- Have a BA degree
- Show fluency in English as demonstrated by a minimum IBT-TOEFL score of 80/120;
- Demonstrate proficiency in speaking, writing, and teaching Modern Standard Arabic.

- Provide copies of all university diplomas and official transcripts;
- Submit three letters of recommendation on-line;
- Provide a copy of the bio page of the applicant's passport

All applications must be submitted on-line before **September 16, 2013**. Applications submitted after this date will **NOT** be reviewed.
