FULBRIGHT FOREIGN STUDENT PROGRAM

You are invited to apply for a Fulbright Graduate Scholarship sponsored by the U.S. Department of State and administered by AMIDEAST for the 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 academic years.

There are two different Fulbright Graduate scholarships available for Tunisian students. One provides successful candidates with a maximum of two years of funding toward a master's degree. The other provides graduate-level students currently enrolled in doctoral programs the opportunity to conduct research in U.S. institutions of higher education for one academic year in the context of cultural and academic exchange.

These scholarships cover expenses incurred for travel to and from the United States, tuition, books, health coverage, as well as living stipends. Funding is NOT available to meet expenses related to Fulbright grantees' dependents (husbands, wives, children, parents, etc).

The J. William Fulbright Foreign Scholarship Board (FSB) regulations prohibit medical degrees, and this has been interpreted as degrees for medical doctors, dentists, nursing, and specializations in the medical and dental fields. Per the Fulbright regulations, doctors and nurses can pursue academic degrees, such as a Masters of Public Health, and nurses can pursue degrees in Nursing Administration or Nursing Education.

Eligibility:

To participate in the Fulbright Foreign Student Program, the applicant must:

- Be a Tunisian citizen and resident of Tunisia at the time of application;
- Have completed an undergraduate degree, have the equivalent of a Bachelor's degree program or be currently enrolled in a doctoral program (*for doctoral research applications);
- Hold a strong academic record;
- Be fluent in English as demonstrated by a valid TOEFL iBT score of 80 or TOEFL ITP score of 550.
