

Fulbright Visiting Scholar Program: 2017 – 2018 Academic Year

The Fulbright Visiting Scholar program brings accomplished Tunisian scholars to the United States to conduct advanced research at U.S. universities for a period up to one academic year.

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be citizens of Tunisia and residing in Tunisia at the time of application.
- Applicants must hold a doctoral degree or equivalent professional qualification at the time of application.

Eligible Research Fields:

- All fields of study are eligible, with the exception of medical/clinical research that involves clinical training, patient care or patient contact.

Selection Criteria:

- Applicants must submit a detailed statement of proposed research activity at a U.S. university.
- Applicants must possess English language proficiency sufficient to achieve the project goals.
- Applicant should demonstrate the intrinsic value of the project to the scholar, his/her home institution, country and U.S. institution.
- Applicant should demonstrate the ability to serve as a cultural ambassador for Tunisia.

Grant Benefits:

- Round-trip travel from Tunisia to a host institution in the United States.
- Full financial support in the United States.
- Medical Insurance.
- Access to professional and cultural enrichment opportunities.
