Who can apply for a YES scholarship? You can!

If you...

- Are between 15 and 17 years old by the time the program begins in August 2017;
- Are currently enrolled in the first or second year of secondary school or equivalent in the French Educational System;
- Have a record of high academic achievements;
- Demonstrate flexibility and commitment to promoting cross-cultural understanding;
- Have good English language abilities;
- Are not a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
