Complete the OFFER portion of the Standard Form 1449, including all blank spaces, and have the form signed by an authorized representative of your company, or the proposal may be considered unacceptable and may be rejected.

In order for a proposal to be considered, you must also complete and submit the following:

1. A completed solicitation, in which the SF-1449 cover page (blocks 12, 17, 19-24, and 30 as appropriate), and Section 1 has been filled out.
2. List of clients the bidder is servicing, demonstrating prior experience in all aspects of "General Laws and Sales of Properties" within Ankara to include relevant past performance (number of cases won) and references with telephone numbers.
3. Evidence of "Bar" membership, legal expertise in sales of properties and international law for at least one other attorney that will be appointed to assist the government.

4. Resume of the attorney that will serve as principal point of contact to the Embassy. The U.S. Government will only deal with one person. The principal POC must be fluent in written and oral English.

The Contracting Officer reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and to waive any informality in proposals received. In addition, the Embassy reserves the right to establish a competitive range of one or more offerors and to conduct further negotiations concerning price and other terms before awarding the contract, or to award without discussions.
