01	Would the government consider adding a CLIN Item Number for Mobilization costs and Demobilization costs?	Yes. A separate CLIN can be added to the contract.
02	When is it anticipated that the award for this contract will be announced?	Approximately between December 21st and 24th
03	The solicitation indicates that invoices shall be submitted to the US Mission Kampala. Will the Mission be able to make payment in USD in the USA?	Payment can be made by EFT.
04	Is the Government requiring prospective Contractors must be registered in the System for Award Management (SAM) prior to award of the contract?	It is preferable if the Contractor is registered in SAM prior to award. If they are not registered in SAM, they must do so upon notification of receipt of award.
05	Is it possible for the Government to extend the bid closing date from 20DEC12 until 28DEC12, in order to allow for a timely response to questions and sufficient time for sourcing with vendors?	The Government will extend the date that solicitations are due from 20 DEC 2012 to 21 DEC 2012, 5:00 PM local Kampala time.
06	Can a pricing discount in exchange for expedited payment of invoices be offered?	Prompt payment discounts are authorized.
07	What is the likelihood that Option 1 and or Option 2 will be exercised?	If performance is satisfactory, and the camp continues to support personnel, the likelihood high.
08	In light of the very short period from award of contract and the commencement of the services, would there be the opportunity to extend the process by two weeks, with a start date of the services on Monday 14th January 2013?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · The award will be made before end of the year, with intention to award before Christmas. · The Marines would enter camp on/about the 15th of Jan · The facilities are already in place- <p>The above 3 making it possible to mobilize themselves from award date- and access the camp from 1 Jan.
