## **SMART ENGLISH CAMP: METHODS OF SUMMER ENGLISH CAMP ORGANIZATION.**

**May 19-20, 2016**

### **PROGRAM GOAL**

The program is aimed at providing assistance to secondary school English teachers on best practices in organizing English Language Camps. Invited U.S. Specialist will train the participants to become English Camp facilitators and coordinators. Possible topics will include: roles of counselors/teachers, camp design, schedules, project-based activities, group work, camp games, and art with few resources.

### **NUMBER OF THE PARTICIPANTS**

We are inviting 25 teachers. The available slots will be divided as below:

50%	English language teachers displaced from the territories of Donetsk and Luhansk oblasts as well as English teachers residing in Donetsk and Luhansk territories controlled by Ukraine.
50%	English teachers, members of TESOL- Ukraine from across Ukraine.

### **SELECTION PROCEDURE**

The participants will be selected on the *first come first served basis*. Successful candidates will receive 9 hours of training, complimentary one-night lodging at the university hotel, coffee breaks, and a Certificate of Participation. Conference participants are responsible for arranging their own transportation to and from the training site.

Sessions will begin at 10 a.m. on May 19 and end by late afternoon on May 20, 2016. Please make your travel arrangements accordingly.

**Dr. Leslie Opp-Beckman** is on faculty at the University of Oregon, College of Arts and Sciences, American English Institute in Eugene, Oregon (USA). She is the Director of Innovative Programming for face-to-face, online, and hybrid (blended) courses for English language learners and educators. She has published, lectured and conducted professional training workshops in the area of Computer Assisted Language Learning (CALL) for English extensively across the United States and internationally in more than 40 countries, including Ukraine. Some of her key projects include the video-based teacher training materials "Shaping the Way We Teach English," contributions to the text "Online Language Teacher Education," and program development and administration for projects such as the "E-Teacher Scholarship Program" and the "Access Teacher Development Online Program."
