SECTION I - THE SCHEDULE / PRICING

The Bureau of International Narcotics and Law Enforcement Affairs (INL) will support the National Police Recruitment Center in Kyiv, Ukraine.

Currently the National Police is seeking assistance in procuring and equipping a server room for the Recruitment Center. The main role of the Center, with regional representative offices within its structure, is selecting candidates for service at the National Police of Ukraine as well as technical assistance in their appraisal, assessment and development.

INL will assist during the development of informational and organizational interaction within and between the Recruitment Centers to ensure proper evaluation of professional aptitude and personal qualities of a police officer, their education and proficiency levels based on comprehensive assessment of compliance to a particular position, as well as quality and unbiased recruitment and selection process of personnel, whose professional level and personal qualities comply with the Police requirements, and who also can professionally fulfill police duties.

Hence, INL has a requirement to purchase items necessary for the Server Room equipment and their installation and monitoring/control in the National Police Recruitment Center. A **one-year warranty** is required.
