

Embassy Property Disposal Sale – March 3, 2012

The Embassy will hold a sealed bid sale at the Embassy's warehouse at 37A Dovbusha St. on Saturday, March 3, 2012, from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM.

Items for sale will include used household appliances, furniture, rugs, office furniture, computers, construction materials and miscellaneous equipment.

All sales will be in Ukrainian Hryvnyas. The Embassy reserves unconditionally the right to refuse any bid.

All items are for sale on an "as-is, where-is" basis. No repairs or refurbishing of any kind will be done by the Embassy. The Embassy makes no warranties or guarantees, except that the U.S. Embassy owns this property. Each buyer is responsible for any tax or custom duties, which may be due at the time of payment. A list of all winning bidders will be provided to the tax authorities if requested by the tax authority office.

The sale results will be published at <http://ukraine.usembassy.gov/> and will become known to public on Monday, March 5, from 10:00am. The hard copy with sale results will be displayed at 4 Sikorskogo near the consular section entrance. The successful bidders should pay their lots at the ProCredit bank only. In order to collect their winning lots the bidders should submit the ProCredit bank receipts to the embassy warehouse responsible staff. The items can be collected from the warehouse Monday and Tuesday from 10:00am till 6:00pm. All purchasers must provide their own transportation and laborers for the items purchased. The U.S. Embassy will not deliver any item(s) and will not move any purchased item(s) onto or into the purchaser's transport.
