Security Message for U.S. Citizens:

Protests in Brussels

On November 7 and 8, 2014.

The U.S. Embassy Brussels informs all U.S. citizens that protests will occur on November 7 and 8, 2014 in Brussels.

- A vigil in support of democracy in Ethiopia will take place at Schuman Place, near the EU Commission (in blue on map) on Friday November 7, 2014 from 14:00 to 16:00 hours. Approximately 250 persons are expected. Belgian police will be present.
- A march in support of tolerance and equality will take place in the vicinity of the Midi Station, via route shown on map (in red) from 15:00 to 19:00 hours on Saturday November 8, 2014. Approximately 400 persons are expected. Belgian police will be present.

Demonstrations intended to be peaceful can turn confrontational and escalate into violence. You should avoid areas of demonstrations, and exercise caution if in the vicinity of any large gatherings, protests, or demonstrations.

We strongly recommend that U.S. citizens traveling to or residing in Belgium enroll in the Department of State's [Smart Traveler Enrollment Program \(STEP\)](#). STEP enrollment gives you the latest security updates, and makes it easier for the U.S. embassy or nearest U.S. consulate to contact you in an emergency. If you don't have Internet access, enroll directly with the nearest U.S. embassy or consulate.
