## **Security Message for U.S. Citizens:**

### **Traffic alert in Brussels**

**May 6, 2015.**

The U.S. Embassy Brussels informs all U.S. citizens of a traffic alert that is expected in Brussels. Police will maintain order.

On Wednesday, May 6 there is a likelihood of crowds and traffic in the city around Place Luxembourg (in red on map) in connection with the scheduled Millennium Youth Project Festival. Particularly large crowds, of 2,000 people or more, and heavy or diverted traffic can be expected in the festival area from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. For more information, please visit the Festival website at: <http://www.millenniumyouthproject.org/en/about>.

Demonstrations intended to be peaceful can turn confrontational and escalate into violence. You should avoid areas of demonstrations, and exercise caution if in the vicinity of any large gatherings, protests, or demonstrations.




