Sign-up and Visiting Procedures for the Educational Advising Center

1. Send request to Tashkent-Advising@state.gov or call 140-2447 at least 24 hours in advance. Provide your:
 - last and first name
 - passport number
 - date of birth
 - time and date you want to visit the EAC
2. If you send your request via e-mail, you will receive registration confirmation by e-mail. If you call, you will get immediate confirmation over the phone.
3. Bring your passport in order to enter the U.S. Embassy building.
4. Come at least 30 minutes early and wait in the Information Resource Center (IRC). The Educational adviser will invite you in when it is time for the meeting or activity.
