The U.S Government intends to award a contract/purchase order for each requirement to the responsible company submitting an acceptable quotation at the lowest price. Quotes must be valid for a minimum of 120 calendar days . We intend to award a contract/purchase order based on initial quotations, without holding discussions, although we may hold discussion with companies in the competitive range if there is a need to do so.

The U.S Government will review your proposal. The proposal must have the company registration record in the System for Award Management (SAM) with the Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) number and the NATO Commercial and Government Entity (NCAGE) Code for doing business with the U.S Government. If you already have the SAM record available please submit the confirmation letter together with the proposal for our review. If you don't have the SAM record please find the attached instructions, or contact Bui Huyen Trang at BuiTH@state.gov for assistance.

Quotations are due at 15:00, December 25, 2015.
