The dehumidifiers must:

- Total weight of the unit should be 10 kg or less with nice design
- Have convenient water disposal with a bucket for water collection
- Have a carbon filter to help clean the air from dust and large particles.
- Should automatically restart after bucket is empty
- Have timed automatic shut off of the unit for 2, 4 or 8 hours ahead.
- Have an ionizer to help remove dust and germs and further enhances the quality of the air.
- Should automatically restart to its previous operating settings after a loss of power
- Have capacity at 30 C degree of 20 liter per day
