



Vietnamese Scholar Program

- The grant covers:
 - Monthly stipends
 - Accident and health insurance
 - Round-trip airfare
- Grant duration: 3 – 9 months
- 7 – 10 grants per year
- Up to now, nearly 100 scholars have participated in this program




Eligibility Requirements:

Applicants must:


- Be a Vietnamese citizen
- Hold an M.A. or Ph.D. (or equivalent degree in some specific professionals)
- Be proficient in English
- Submit a complete application before the deadline of October 15, 2012






Preparing the Application


A complete application package includes:

- An application form
- A detailed project statement
- A professional curriculum vitae;
- Three letters of reference
- Letters of invitation (if applicable)
- Bibliography & course syllabi (if applicable)




The Application form

- On-line application is available at:

- General guidelines:
 1. Read carefully the detailed instructions
 2. All items must be in English.
 3. The entire application must be typed or computer-generated.
 4. Limit your answers to the given space
 5. Treat the application as a unitary whole, with all parts reinforcing the project statement.




Letters of Reference

- You must submit three references. Do not submit more than three references.
- The references must be written in or translated into English.
- It's your responsibility to ensure that reference letters are submitted by the deadline.



Reviewing your application


- Proofread every part of your application
- Do spell-check
- Make a copy of your completed application



Deadline:

Monday, October 15, 2012

- Your fully completed Fulbright application is due no later than 5:00 p.m., October 15, 2012
- Mailed, faxed or emailed copies will NOT be accepted
- NO exceptions will be given
