BASIC FUNCTION OF THE POSITION

The American Center Student Internship benefits both the U.S. Embassy and student interns by providing a valuable educational experience to students while assisting the Embassy accomplish important mission goals. American Center Student Interns will be responsible for hosting the American English Club and/ or Book Club and film show discussion programs at the American Center. American Center Student Interns will also assist with all American Center programs and activities, re-shelve books and magazines, work on collections, greet and assist patrons and help them adhere to Center regulations. QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

All applicants are instructed to address each selection criterion detailed below with specific and comprehensive information supporting each item.

1. Must be a currently enrolled university student in Vietnam. (Non-U.S. citizen)
2. Must have good communication skills, experience in public speaking or "MCing".
3. Must be at least 18 years of age at the time of appointment.
4. Must have demonstrated the potential to accomplish the type of work to be performed.
5. Good command of both spoken and written English is required (this will be tested).

PLEASE NOTE: INTERNS ARE NOT CONSIDERED U.S. EMBASSY EMPLOYEES

- ❖ **The intern is not considered a Federal employee for most purposes.**
- ❖ **There will be NO employment benefits associated with this position, including: annual leave accrual, sick leave, etc.**
- ❖ **There will be NO compensation or payment.**

ADDITIONAL SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Non-host country foreign nationals who are legal resident students of Vietnam are required to submit the same documentation as the other applicants, and also legal residency permit for consideration.
2. All Foreign National Student Intern Program applicants must have graduated from high school or equivalent secondary school prior to beginning program.
3. If selected, candidates will be required to produce a "Letter of Introduction" from their university.
4. If selected, the student will receive a security background check.

TO APPLY

Interested candidates for this position must submit the following, or the application will not be considered:

1. Application for Foreign National Student Intern Program (find the attached form).
2. Statement of interest form (attached) should include the student's objectives and motivations in seeking an internship and how their academic courses and other experiences relate to the Mission's goals/ American Center's needs.
3. Gratuitous Service Agreement (Attached)
4. A copy of ID card and student card.
5. Copy of most recent academic transcript.
6. Any other documentation (e.g., essays, certificates, awards, copies of degrees earned, etc.) that addresses the qualification requirements of the position as listed above.
