Program Description: Secondary school students (ages 15-17) and educators (teachers/community leaders) from VIETNAM are invited to apply for participation in the Southeast Asia Youth Leadership Program (SEAYLP) during October 28 – November 19, 2012. Managed by the East-West Center, a Honolulu-headquartered education and research organization, SEAYLP will take place in Hawaii, California, and Washington, D.C., and will engage participants in the activities of U.S. schools, community organizations, youth groups, and community leaders that explore the principles of civic engagement and leadership through the lens of “green and sustainable schools and communities.” In particular, participants will learn how youth in the United States exercise their rights as well as fulfill their civic responsibilities to better their communities, and as part of follow-on activities, they will undertake positive civic and leadership roles by conducting “green” projects in their own schools and home communities.

The program will be intensive, academic, and interactive. As such, the program sponsors seek energetic applicants who are ready to develop their skills in order to be effective leaders in their schools and communities.
