This program allows undergraduate students to participate in a one-year exchange at a U.S. university or college.

This program offers undergraduate students the opportunity to improve their leadership skills in a five-week civic education course at a U.S. university.

## U.S. EMBASSY PROGRAMS FOR SCHOLARS AND PROFESSIONALS

- **Fulbright Master's Degree Scholarship**

This program offers Yemeni students the opportunity to obtain two-year master's degree from a U.S. university in almost any field.

- **Fulbright Post-Doctoral Fellowship**

This program offers Yemeni doctorate-holders the opportunity to conduct an individual research project at a U.S. university for six to nine months.

- **Fulbright Foreign Language Teaching Assistant (FLTA) Program**

This program sends young teachers to a U.S. university or college for nine months to teach Arabic as a second language to undergraduate students while taking classes at the university.

- **Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship**

This program allows accomplished mid-career professionals in both the public and private sectors to study at a U.S. university that offers a highly intensive, one-year academic training program in their field.

- **The Middle East Partnership Initiative (MEPI) Leaders for Democracy Fellowship**

This program offers mid-career professionals in both the public and private sectors the opportunity to improve their leadership skills in a five-week civic education course at a U.S. university.

- **Study of the U.S. Institute for Scholars Program**

This program promotes a better understanding of the people, institutions, and culture of the United States for scholars in the fields of American Politics and Political Thought, Contemporary American Literature, Journalism and Media, Religious Pluralism in the United States, U.S. Culture and Society, U.S. Foreign Policy, U.S. National Security, and Secondary School Education.
