Security Message for U.S. Citizens

Possible Demonstrations in Mongu

The U.S. Embassy has received reports of possible demonstrations in Mongu tomorrow, July 25, and advises U.S. citizens to avoid the area. Persons already in Mongu should consider staying in their home or in a safe location. Persons outside of Mongu should defer their travel there to a later date.

As occurs around the world, spontaneous demonstrations can take place in Zambia from time to time in response to world events or local developments. We remind U.S. citizens that even demonstrations intended to be peaceful can sometimes turn confrontational and possibly escalate into violence without advance warning. U.S. citizens are, therefore, urged to avoid demonstrations, and to exercise caution if within the vicinity of any demonstrations. U.S. citizens are also advised to stay current with news media coverage of local events and to be aware of their surroundings at all times.
