**SCAM ALERT !**

Several Embassies/Consulates have reported that some vendors in their areas have been receiving tenders/requests for quotations purporting to be from the U.S. Embassy, in which they are asked to provide a price quote for 10 solar generators, and to deliver the generators to the Embassy as samples, which will qualify them to be a regular supplier of 150 generators. The tenders are being sent to the vendors via email from the address [usa@embassytenders.com](mailto:usa@embassytenders.com) and include attached specs and an official-looking RFQ form on fake Embassy letterhead complete with a fake Embassy seal.

**Please Note:** the U.S. Embassy in Dublin does not send out tender notices from the above email address.
