

How do I comply with *One Full Calendar Month* travel in the U.S.?

This means you have to be lawfully present in the U.S. before the first minute of the first day of a month and stay until after the last minute of the last day of that month. The example below suggests that you must

1. Enter the U.S. anytime in the previous month (example: September 30);
2. Stay for all 24 hours of each day in the following calendar month (example, October);
3. Then, depart after the new month has begun (example: November 1).
