- Professional Qualifications. The Architect/Engineer firm must have the required licenses to perform the work required, to include but not be limited to Mayor's Permit, Business Permit, DTI/SEC registration and certificate of membership in professional association or accreditation;
- Demonstrated success and past performance in the preparation of reports on structural engineering, fire safety and seismic review.
- Personnel capacity to accomplish the work in the required time. Licensed Architect/Structural Engineer with at least five (5) years experience working in specialized discipline. Specialized experience and technical competence in the type of work required (i.e. property survey, evaluation and report preparation)
