Emergency Message for U.S. Citizens  
Airport Security**

In response to recent attacks in Brussels, Moroccan authorities have enhanced security measures at all international airports. Travelers should expect additional security screenings at Rabat-Sale Airport and Mohammed V International Airport in Casablanca.

Mission Morocco has been notified that visitors without passports or tickets will not be granted access to the airports. Individuals coming to the airport for official business will be escorted by members of Moroccan security services. Additionally, police K9 units will be inspecting all luggage and handbags brought to the airport by travelers.

The U.S. Mission suggests that travelers bring printed copies of their tickets and be prepared for delays at the airports. The current threat environment in Africa, Europe, and elsewhere, requires additional vigilance on the part of any traveler in the region.
