IMPORTANT NOTE

*Flu vaccine is only given during the fall season.

Please take the following documents to the doctor's office when presenting for the medical examination:

- Original Passport along with two photocopies.
- Two Photographs signed on the front and full name written on the back in BLOCK letters.
- Packet 3.5 cover letter issued by the Consular Section or any other documentation issued by the US Embassy or the National Visa Center showing your visa category.
- Documents pertaining to your previous medical or surgical history.
- Prescription of medicines or injections you are currently using.

All applicants under the age of 15 are required to go through a physical examination only. However, the panel physician may require an applicant less than 15 years of age to go through a chest X-ray and blood test for sexually transmitted disease.

Please wear loose clothes and avoid wearing unnecessary jewelry, when visiting the panel physician's clinic for medical examination.

In IR-5 cases, children regardless of age may not accompany and should not have their medical performed.
