This event is FREE to the public! It will help prospective students and their parents seeking to learn about educational options and programs in the U.S. and Canada.

College Fair 2014 is one of the largest tertiary education fairs in the region with over 75 colleges and universities confirmed to participate. Representatives from educational institutions from the United States, Canada, Trinidad and Tobago and the wider Caribbean will be available to answer your questions on applications, admissions, visas, scholarships and financing.

The Embassy of the United States of America will host information sessions from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. to 3 p.m. each day on life at U.S. Universities and the student visa application process. Flagler College and Florida International University will also provide separate presentations on their schools. All these presentations will be held in the Jade and Ruby meeting rooms.

Similarly, representatives from Citizenship and Immigration Canada will be on hand on both Fair days to answer questions about study permits, and student visas, as well as provide information on work study options in Canada.
