

## Global Entry Program in Singapore, U.S. Embassy

Global Entry is a CBP program that allows expedited clearance for pre-approved, low-risk travelers upon arrival in the United States. Though intended for frequent international travelers, there is no minimum number of trips necessary to qualify for the program. Participants may enter the United States by using automated kiosks located at select airports. Global Entry is currently available at 34 U.S. airports, as well as 8 Preclearance airports in Canada, and 2 Preclearance sites in Ireland.

Global Entry is designed to be quick, efficient and, at the same time, provide added security for international travelers. While Global Entry's goal is to speed travelers through the process, members are still subject to the same laws and regulations as other travelers, and may be selected for further examination at any time when entering the United States.

U.S. Embassy Singapore is **not** an official Enrollment center for the Global Entry program, we provide **Global Entry Interviews** at the Embassy as an accommodation, subject to **terms and conditions (\*)** applied below.

\* You must be a U.S. Citizen or Lawful Permanent Resident (LPR). You can apply for your children under the age of 18, but they must be accompanied by at least one parent or legal guardian at the interview.

\* You are legally residing in Singapore.

\* You have completed the following enrollment steps in the Global Entry Online System (GOES):

- ✓ *You have submitted your [online application](#) and have paid the USD 100 non-refundable application fee*
- ✓ *You have obtained the conditional approval letter notification and an application ID.*
- ✓ *You have selected “Singapore, U.S. Embassy” as the interview site when you scheduled an appointment online (GOES), within 30 days of being conditionally approved.*

Interview slots at the Singapore, U.S. Embassy will be limited to **Wednesday mornings from 9am to 12noon.**

At the interview, a U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) officer will ask you questions, take your photo, and collect biometric information, e.g., scan your fingerprints.

*What you need to bring to the interview:*

- U.S. Citizens must bring your valid U.S. passport (or passports if you have more than one). If you are a Lawful Permanent Resident (LPR), you must present your permanent resident card (green card).
- Each Interviewee is required to bring an additional photo ID card (such as a driver's license or any photo ID) to exchange for a temporary entry badge at the Embassy security guard desk, before you step into the Embassy lobby. Children will show their passport ID at the guard posts and will keep their passports for the Global Entry Interview.
- Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by at least one guardian or parent who has legal custody of the children, and are required to provide copies of the legal custody documents (e.g. Birth Certificate, Notarized letter etc.).

*Please take note:*

- There is no parking provided at the Embassy, cell-phones and other electronic gadgets will be held at the security guard posts.
- Upon your arrival at the Embassy lobby, please approach the front desk receptionist/ guard and wait for an escort to the Global Entry meeting room.
