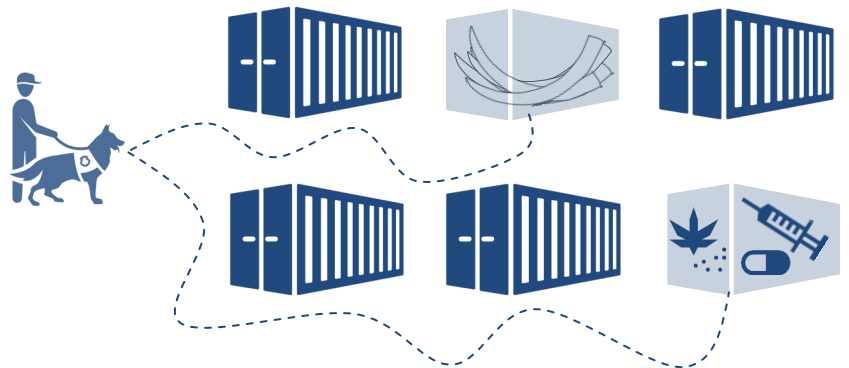
About Belgian Malinois

The four dogs in Canine Detection Program Tanzania are all Belgian Malinois, a breed known for its athleticism, energy, and trainability.

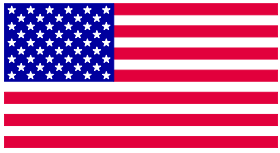

- Wildlife and narcotics trafficking are serious crimes with devastating consequences for Tanzania’s natural resources, economy, and security.
- Through four canines and training from **U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP)**, U.S. Embassy Dar es Salaam has equipped police working at Julius Nyerere International Airport and the Port of Dar es Salaam with the capability to detect a variety of illegally trafficked items, including wildlife products and drugs.
- The four Tanzanian handlers are police officers from the **Tanzania Police’s Dog and Horse Unit** who were specially selected for this program by the Office of the Inspector General of Police.
- The four canines and their Tanzanian handlers were trained and certified in 2015 at CBP’s world class facility in El Paso, Texas. In February 2016, CBP’s trainers arrived to conduct on-the-job training at the airport and port.
- The Canine Detection Program is a model of what can be achieved when partners work together. **Stopping the poaching crisis and illicit narcotics trafficking requires everyone to contribute:** government officials, security forces, the international community, NGOs, businesses, and Tanzanian citizens across the nation.



Canine detection teams that include a Tanzanian police officer handler and a police canine trained by U.S. Customs and Border Protection can now identify containers with illegal wildlife products or drugs.

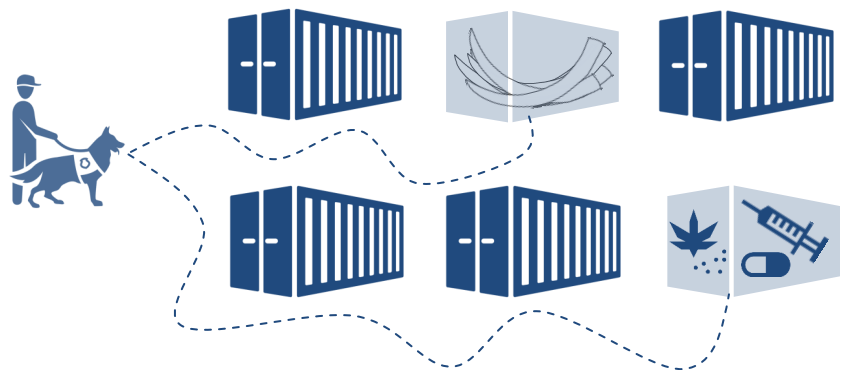
Kuhusu mbwa aina ya Belgian Malinois

Mbwa wote wanne waliomo katika programu hii ni aina ya Belgian Malinois ambao wanasifika kwa nguvu na uwezo wao wa kuhimili mikiki mikiki na kufundishika.

Tafadhali wasiliana na Kitengo cha Masuala ya Umma cha Ubalozi wa Marekani kwa barua pepe:

- Usafirishaji haramu wa bidhaa zitokazo na wanyamapori na madawa ya kulevya ni uhalifu mkubwa wenye athari kubwa kwa maliasili, uchumi na usalama wa Tanzania.
- Kwa kutoa mbwa wanne na kuwezesha mafunzo yaliyofanyika katika chuo cha **Forodha na Ulinzi wa Mipaka ya Marekani (CBP)**, Ubalozi wa Marekani Dar es Salaam umewapatia polisi wanaofanya kazi katika kiwanja cha ndege cha kimataifa cha Julius Nyerere na Bandari ya Dar es Salaam uwezo wa kubaini bidhaa haramu zinazovushwa katika maeneo hao zikiwemo nyara za serikali na madawa ya kulevya.
- Askari wanne wa Kitanzania wanaowasimamia mbwa hao wanatoka katika **Kikosi cha Mbwa na Farasi**. Wao waliteuliwa kushiriki katika programu hii na ofisi ya Mkuu wa Jeshi la Polisi (IGP).
- Mbwa hawa pamoja na askari walipata mafunzo na kufuzu katika chuo adhimu cha CBP kilichopo El Paso, Texas. Februari 2016 wakufunzi kutoka chuo hicho waliwasili nchini kutoa mafunzo zaidi kwa vitendo katika eneo lao la kazi, uwanjani na bandarini.
- Programu ya Mbwa Maalumu wa Uchunguzi ni mfano ya mafanikio yanayoweza kupatikana pale wabia wanapofanya kazi pamoja. **Kutokomeza janga la ujangili na usafirishaji wa madawa ya kulevya kunahitaji mchango wa kila mmoja wetu:** maafisa wa serikali, vyombo vya usalama, jumuiya ya kimataifa, Asasi Zisizo za Kiserikali, wafanyabiashara na Watanzania wote popote walipo nchini.



Timu za uchunguzi zikijumuisha Askari wa Kitanzania na mbwa wao waliopata mafunzo katika chuo cha Forodha na Ulinzi wa Mipaka ya Marekani wanaweza sasa kubaini konteina lililo na nyara za serikali au madawa ya kulevya.
