

Deputy Chief of Mission Travels Across Togo

Deputy Chief of Mission (DCM) Simon Hankinson recently completed his final upcountry journey a month before wrapping up his three-year tour in Togo. The trip participants circumnavigated all five regions of the country and visited a wide range of inspiring projects, associations, and people.

The whirlwind tour stopped at five Self-Help projects, and the DCM led discussions on good governance at schools in Kpalimé, Kara and Dapaong. After a radio interview in Sokodé, the DCM met with several Muslim community leaders (along with many horses!). Embassy staff distributed copies of the anti-corruption comic book *Le Bon, La Bourse et Le Corrompu* at multiple locations, including six libraries and three schools.
